

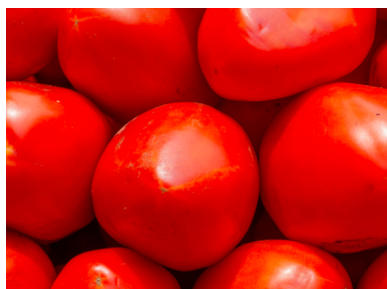

Superfresh Growers forecasts strong blueberry season

With harvest around the corner, Superfresh Growers is optimistic about a strong, promotable season for its blueberry program, backed by favorable growing conditions and an evolving consumer landscape that's driving fresh demand. Operating out of two strategic Pacific Northwest locations — Oregon's Umpqua River Valley and Washington's Skagit Valley — the company reports that an ideal combination of rainfall, snowpack and spring weather has created "an excellent foundation for this year's crop," according to Ryan Cleary, director of blueberries for Superfresh Growers. The geographic locations of its growing regions not only mitigate risk but ensure consistent volume and quality throughout the season. "Our variety diversity ensures a blueberry program that flows smoothly from mid-June through September," said Cleary.

At the farm level, quality starts with trusted partnerships. Superfresh blueberries are grown and packed by growers with a deep commitment to excellence. "We partner with family farms that are known for their farming passion and expertise and sophisticated packing lines," said Cleary. "These combined create excellent eating blueberries that deliver on their reputation." Superfresh Growers also emphasizes transparency and storytelling as part of its retail strategy.
