University extension says timing is right to plant Florida avocado trees
The University of Florida's Institute of Food and Agricultural Sciences Extension in Miami-Dade
County shares tips for and the science behind successful avocado growing in the home landscape.

With Cinco de Mayo approaching, the University of Florida's Institute of Food and Agricultural Sciences Extension in Miami-Dade County says now is the time to dig into guacamole and plant avocado trees in the state.

Florida avocados offer a fresh, tropical twist on this fan-favorite fruit that stars in so many recipes, UF/IFAS said in a news release, adding that they also have less fat than the hass variety and 60% more potassium than bananas.

Florida has been home to avocado trees since 1833, and today it ranks as the No. 2 avocado-producing state in the nation, the release said. Jeff Wasielewski, a commercial tropical fruit agent with UF/IFAS Extension in Miami-Dade County, hosts a series of webinars on tropical fruit for growers and consumers to which the public can also subscribe.
