Variety innovation & consumer marketing help drive demand for Southeast berries

The region is a key hub for berry production, supplying retailers with an early season of fresh strawberries, blueberries and more.

Growers in the Southeast play an important role in keeping the produce aisle stocked with fresh berries.

Florida is the first state to harvest domestic blueberries each year, giving it a competitive advantage in the U.S. market by meeting consumer demand for fresh blueberries during a key sales window, according to International Blueberry Organization.

In 2023, Florida ranked second in value of production for bell peppers, all oranges, strawberries, tomatoes grown in the open, and non-valencia oranges, according to the Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services, with its strawberries at 13% of U.S. value at \$434 million. As consumer demand for berries grows, Southeast growers are turning to technology to enhance efficiency, boost yields and maintain fruit quality.
