Michigan Apple Season Outlook Brings Optimism and Strong Retail Opportunities Marketers say regional advantages and smart packaging strategies position the Wolverine State for a robust harvest.

It's still too early to give a full report on the Michigan apple season, but the season is shaping up well, says Diane Smith, executive director of the Michigan Apple Committee.

The weather in spring can influence pollination and fruit set, says Chuck Sinks, president of sales and marketing, Honeybear Brands. Ideal temperatures and adequate moisture levels during bloom help create a favorable environment for pollination, but cold or wet conditions can negatively affect pollination and lead to lower yields, he says.

Weathering the Spring for a Promising Harvest

Trish Taylor, marketing and account manager for Riveridge Produce Marketing Inc., says the cool weather this spring "made for a longer, more drawn-out pollination period." But, she adds, "Some blocks set better than others, depending on when they reached full bloom."
